Why Chiropractic? People go to Chiropractors for a variety of reasons. Some go for symptomatic relief of pain or discomfort (Relief Care). RELIEF CARE

Relief Care is that care necessary to get rid of your symptoms or pain, but not the cause of it. It is the same as drying a floor that was getting wet from a leak, but not fixing the leak.

CORRECTIVE CARE

Corrective care differs from relief care in that its goal is to get rid of the symptoms or pain while correcting the cause of the problem. Corrective care varies in length of time, but is more lasting.
